## ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By this application The San Joaquin Canal Company sought authority to enter into a contract with Sam Hamburg, one of its consumers, providing for the production of well water by Hamburg at certain points on applicant's rights of way, the diversion of such water into applicant's canals immediately adjacent to such wells, and the diversion of an equivalent quantity of irrigation water by Hamburg from applicant's Outside Canal during specified periods in the summer months of each year. A public hearing on the application was held at Los Banos on January 16, 1950.

On January 25, 1950, applicant filed with the Commission a request in writing for dismissal of the application without prejudice, wherein it is alleged that applicant does not now believe that well water can be produced which will meet the standard of quality contemplated by the proposed contract, as amended. Applicant further states that Hamburg has been advised of the utility's intention to request dismissal of the application and that he has no objection to such dismissal.

Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the above entitled and numbered application be and it is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
