SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 43356, applicant was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the transportation of persons between Victorville Army Air Base and Air Base Housing Project, on the one hand, and Victorville and Victorville Housing Project, on the other hand, subject to a restriction that all passengers must either originate at, or be destined to, the Victorville Army Air Base or the Air Base Housing Project adjacent to said air base.

Applicant requests that it be granted a 90-day extension of time for the establishment of said service and to comply with the provisions of General Order No. 79, and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A, for the reason that the activation of the air base has been delayed and that the housing projects have not yet been approved by the Federal Housing Administration. No transportation service will be required until the air base is operating and the housing projects have been at least partially completed.

An extension of time appears to be in the public interest and therefore the application will be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

ORDER

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that subparagraph (b) of paragraph (2) of Part II of the Order in Decision No. 43356, on Application No. 30552, be, and it hereby is, amended to read as follows:

- (b) Applicant shall, within one hundred sixty (160) days after the effective date hereof, and upon not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public, establish the service herein authorized and comply with the provisions of General Order No. 79 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A by filing, in triplicate, and concurrently making effective, tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
