## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION

The Commission by Decision No. 43731 issued in this proceeding on January 24, 1950, a certificate of public convenience and necessity to applicants D. A. Mitchell and G. V. Clark, doing business as Riske Trucking Co., authorizing operation as a highway common carrier for transportation of truckload traffic shipments of not less than 2000 pounds along various routes described in said decision. It appears that Route No. 4 as described in said Decision No. 43731 fails to include a restriction inserted by amendment to the application. It is, therefore, necessary that the certificate heretofore issued be amended.

## ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 43731 issued herein on January 24, 1950, be amended by eliminating from said decision Route No. 4 and substituting in its place and stead the following:

> Route No. 4: Between all points and places located on and laterally within 3 miles of the highways described in Route No. 2 as route highways between points located on Route No. 1 and said San Francisco territory, on the one hand, end, on the other hand, points and places located in said San Francisco Territory, except that no service will be performed

between said San Francisco Territory, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points on or laterally from U. S. Highway 40 south of Cordelia, points on or laterally from State Highway Route 4 west of its intersection with State Highway Route 21, points on or laterally from State Highway Route 24 west of Walnut Creek, or points on or laterally from U. S. Highway 50 west of Mountain House.
