O R D E R

The verified application of The Western Pacific Railroad Company discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Brush since July 1948, that the industry previously served at said station has discontinued operations in the vicinity and that continued maintenance of the station is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Brush, County of Butte; to remove a spur track located at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
