ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Merchants Parcel Delivery was authorized by Decision No. 43700 of January 17, 1950, in this proceeding, to observe rates lower than the established minimum rates on shipments weighing 100 pounds or less. The authority was limited to deliveries of commodities from retail stores in San Francisco to customers in Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, San Mateo or Santa Clara counties and to commodities returned by the customers to the stores. The order in the decision became effective February 6, 1950. By petition filed February 6, 1950, Merchants seeks extension of the effective date to February 20, 1950. The petition was not filed in time to permit the Commission to take action before the order became effective. Under the circumstances, the petition will be dismissed.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the petition of Merchants Parcel Delivery, filed February 6, 1950, in the above-entitled proceeding, be and it is hereby dismissed.
