SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

modification of the original decision ⁽¹⁾ in this application.

Petitioners request an extension of time in which to
comply with the provision respecting the time allowed for the filing
of tariffs.

It is alleged that due to the death of their tariff
expert who prepared the outline of the tariffs to be filed by these
petitioners it will be impossible to complete the preparation of
said tariff in the final form required to comply with the
Commission's rules and regulations within the time specified in
the original order. The request appears to be justified and
therefore should be granted. Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Paragraph (3) b of Order No. 43427 is hereby
amended to read as follows:

- b. Applicants shall within 150 days after the
effective date of this order and upon not less
than 5 days' notice to the Commission and the

public, establish the service herein authorized and comply with the provisions of General Orders Nos. 80 and 93-A (Part IV), by filing in triplicate, and concurrently making effective, tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission.

(2) That in all other respects the order in Decision No. 43427 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days after the date hereof.
