O P I N I O N

Applicant, Joseph E. Bosso, doing business as Yellow Cab Company, Arrow Cab Company, and Acme Cab Company requests authority to operate a passenger stage service between Watsonville Airport and Santa Cruz.

The service as proposed would be on an on-call basis with a charge of \$2.50 per person between the Airport and the following points in Santa Cruz: 1320 Pacific Avenue, St. George Hotel, Palomar Hotel and Casa Del Rey Hotel. No intermediate points would be served. Seven sedans valued at approximately \$14,300.00 would be utilized in this operation.

As justification for the authority sought applicant alleges that he has received requests for such service from the Southwest Airways, which operates an air service between San Francisco and Watsonville Airport and between Los Angeles and the Watsonville Airport; that the Southwest Airways has no connecting carrier to transport its passengers to and from the Airport and Santa Cruz; that there is no certificated carrier presently serving between the points herein involved with the exception of Pacific Greyhound Lines which serves between Watsonville and Santa Cruz, but does not serve the Airport; that Pacific Greyhound Lines has no objection

to the granting of this application; that he has no outstanding debts other than current accounts and is financially able to render the service proposed.

Applicant's financial statements as of January 31, 1950, disclose a net worth of \$17,800.

After full consideration of the facts, it is the opinion of the Commission that public convenience and necessity require the establishment and operation of the proposed service and the application will be granted. This is not a matter requiring a public hearing.

O R D E R

An application having been filed, the Commission being fully informed, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Joseph E. Bosso authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 2½ of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of passengers between Watsonville Airport and 1320 Pacific Avenue, St. George Hotel, Palomar Hotel and Casa Del Rey Hotel in the City of Santa Cruz.

(2) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with the following service regulations:

- a. Applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed 30 days from the effective date hereof.
- b. Within 60 days from the effective date hereof and on not less than 5 days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and comply with the provisions of General Orders Nos. 79 and 93-A, by filing in triplicate, and concurrently making effective appropriate tariffs and time schedules.
- c. Subject to the authority of this Commission to change or modify it by further order, applicant shall conduct operations over the following route:

Commencing at Watsonville Airport, thence over California Highway No. 1 to Santa Cruz.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days after the date hereof.
