O R D E R

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company dis-
closes that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at
applicant's station of Byron Hot Springs during the past two years
and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized
to abandon its non-agency station of Byron Hot Springs, County of
Contra Costa; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to
cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not
less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the
facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commis-
sion in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised
within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this
order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
