SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

M. R. Woods, doing business as Arcadia Stage Line, conducts operations as a passenger stage corporation between Cotati, Sebastopol, Monte Rio, Villa Grande and Cazadero and intermediate points. He is authorized to handle express shipments limited to 100 pounds or less in weight. He seeks exemption from the established minimum rates in connection with his express traffic.

The type of transportation involved here is similar to that performed by other passenger stage corporations who conduct incidental express services and who have heretofore been granted exemption from the minimum rates. Similar exemption appears justified here. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 31606, as amended, in Case No. 4246, be and it is hereby further amended by adding M. R. Woods, doing business as Arcadia Stage Line, to the list of carriers contained in paragraph (c) of Finding No. 14 thereof.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
