O P I N I O N

Applicant, Emil H. Miller, doing business as the Emil H. Miller Transit Line and presently rendering a passenger stage service between Hayward, Russell City and Mohrland requests authority to discontinue service to the Mohrland area.

The operative right was created by Decision No. 42733 in Application No. 30139.

Applicant's over all operations are afforded through the use of one bus, which applicant operates himself. He operates five schedules a day, with the exception of Sundays. The total route is six miles in length with the Mohrland area covering 2.55 miles of the total route.

As justification for the authority sought applicant alleges that his daily receipts from the Mohrland area range between fifteen cents and sixty cents; that his total operating revenue for the month of December 1949 amounted to \$277.90; that his total operating expense amounted to \$139.55 excluding salary.

It appears that public convenience and necessity do not require the continued operation to Mohrland and the authority to discontinue should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

ORDER

Therefore, good cause appearing,  
IT IS ORDERED

(1) That Emil H. Miller is hereby authorized to  
discontinue and abandon operations to Mohrland.

(2) That the portions of Decision No. 42733 in  
Application No. 30139 authorizing operations to Mohrland are hereby  
revoked and annulled. In all other respects Decision No. 42733  
shall remain in full force and effect.

(3) That applicant shall file in triplicate appropriate  
supplements to his tariffs and time tables within sixty (60) days  
after the effective date hereof and on not less than five (5) days'  
notice to the Commission and the public showing the discontinuance  
of service as heretofore authorized.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days after  
the date hereof.
