INTERIM ORDER

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a side track at grade across Van Allen Road near Avena, San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 2-1105.8. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be fixed by further order of the Commission.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant states that track extension is now under construction and asks that the usual twenty-day waiting period be waived in order that work be not held up.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
