SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the order contained in Decision No. 43594, dated December 7, 1949, in this proceeding granting a certificate of public convenience and necessity to Theo Peters, the applicant herein, provided that within sixty (60) days after the effective date thereof, applicant shall comply with the provisions of General Order No. 80 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A, by filing, in triplicate, and concurrently making effective, appropriate tariffs and time schedules on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public.

WHEREAS, by petition, filed February 10, 1950, applicant seeks an extension of time to comply with said requirement, alleging that, although arrangements were promptly made for the compilation of appropriate tariffs and time schedules, the task of doing so has been more time consuming than was anticipated and that an additional period will be required to complete the preparation of said tariffs and time schedules; and

WHEREAS, it appears that applicant's request is justified and should be granted. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the time for compliance with subparagraph b., paragraph (3), of the order forming a part of Decision No. 43594, dated December 7, 1949, in this proceeding be and it is hereby extended to and including April 26, 1950.

This supplemental order shall become effective on the date hereof.
