O R D E R

This is an application for an order authorizing Southern Pacific Company to transfer to Central Pacific Railway Company certain parcels of land situate in the City of Alameda, as more fully set forth and described in the proposed instrument of conveyance filed in this proceeding. The original cost of said land to Southern Pacific Company is reported at \$22,543.46 and the amount at which it is carried on its books at \$21,070.83.

The line of railroad to which said land is appurtenant is owned by Central Pacific Railway Company and it is the desire of applicants for the title to said land to be vested in the owner of the railroad.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, and that the application should be granted, as herein provided; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. Southern Pacific Company, after the effective date hereof and on or before September 30, 1950, may transfer the property

referred to herein to Central Pacific Railway Company for the sum of \$21,070.83.

2. Within thirty (30) days after the execution of the instrument conveying the properties herein authorized to be transferred, Southern Pacific Company shall file with the Commission a copy thereof as actually executed.

3. The authority herein granted will become effective twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
