I N T E R I M O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct an additional side track at grade across Carrolton Road near Avena, San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 2-1107.1. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding five per cent. Protection shall be fixed by further order of the Commission. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that construction forces are now working

in the vicinity and requests that the usual twenty-day effective date be waived.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
