<u>OPINION</u>

Southern California Edison Company in this proceeding asks for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to exercise the rights and privileges of a franchise granted by the City of Fillmore, permitting the installation, maintenance and use of an electric distribution and transmission system upon the streets of said city.

The franchise referred to, a copy of which is attached to the application and designated as Exhibit "A," was granted by the city in accordance with the Franchise Act of 1937, and is of indeterminate duration. A fee is payable annually to the city equivalent to 2% of the gross receipts arising from the use, operation, or possession of the franchise, but not less than 1% of all sales of electricity within the limits of such city under said franchise.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Southern California Edison Company to exercise the rights and privileges granted by the City of Fillmore by Ordinance No. 207 adopted June 28, 1949.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
