<u>Control of RDER</u> Second Morthern Railway Company is authorized to construct South Avenue and Jessie Avenue at grade across the main line track of Sacramento Northern Railway Company near Del Paso, Sacramento County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings No. 8-99.0 and No. 8-99.7, respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Sacramento Northern Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than five per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs at each location. (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
