O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to reconstruct and widen the crossing of State Highway Route 166 at grade with a track of Pacific Electric Railway Company (Crossing No. 6C-11.32), near Montebello, Los Angeles County, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than 40 feet and grades of approach not greater than three per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 7 wigwags (General Order No. 75-B), relocated to conform to the new pavement width.

Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. In order that temporary detour along stream bed may be discontinued prior to wet weather, applicant requests that order be made effective upon its issuance; therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
