OPINION AND ORDER

Railway Express Agency, Incorporated, seeks authority to discontinue collection and delivery service for express shipments at Scotia, Humboldt County, Shipments would thereafter be received and delivered at applicant's office.

The verified application shows that the express office is centrally located, and that no point at which collection and delivery service is now offered is more than one-fourth mile distant therefrom. The application shows also that all mercantile establishments within the affected area, excepting only one combination garage and service station, are controlled by The Pacific Lumber Company, and that the latter company has no objection to withdrawal of the service as proposed.

It appears that this is a matter on which a public hearing is not necessary, and that the application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-entitled application be and it is hereby granted.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
