for an order authorizing it to transfer and convey a portion of its water distribution facilities.

O R D E R

Park Water Company, Incorporated, a corporation, engaged in the business of distributing and selling water for domestic, commercial and industrial purposes in various sections of Los Angeles County, asks the Commission for authority to sell and transfer a portion of its distribution system located in the community known as Watts to the City of Los Angeles, a municipal corporation, which joins in the application.

The property to be transferred consists of 8,330 feet of steel pipe, varying from 2 to 5 inches in diameter and 94 three-quarter inch galvanized pipe service connections, all located generally between Central Avenue on the west, Compton Avenue on the east, 112th Street on the north, and Imperial Highway on the south, all within the city limits of the City of Los Angeles.

The City of Los Angeles has water distribution facilities installed in adjoining territory and can serve adequately and immediately the consumers now being supplied by the Park Water Company. The sale price of the property to be transferred is the sum of \$1,000 and is payable in cash upon consummation of the sale.

It appearing that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted in the public interest, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Park Water Company, Incorporated, may, on and after the effective date hereof and on or before the thirtieth (30th) day of June, 1950, sell and transfer for the sum of \$1,000 the water distribution facilities, including certain pipe lines and service connections located in the community of Watts to the City of Los Angeles, a public corporation, as set forth more particularly in the application herein.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED as follows:

1. Park Water Company, Incorporated, shall file with this Commission two certified copies of the final instrument of conveyance of the properties herein authorized to be transferred within thirty (30) days after consummation thereof.
2. Park Water Company, Incorporated, within thirty (30) days thereafter shall file with this Commission a written statement indicating the date it relinquished control and possession of the properties herein authorized to be transferred.

The action taken herein shall not be construed as a finding of the value of the properties herein authorized to be transferred.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
