SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER


By prior orders in this proceeding, the Commission has authorized applicant to deviate from the established minimum rates in connection with the transportation of property for General Mills, Inc.-Sperry Division. The authority is limited to operations in southern California. It is scheduled to expire May 11, 1950. Permission thereafter to continue to observe the present rates is now sought.

The verified supplemental application shows that the circumstances and conditions which justified deviation from the minimum rates continue to prevail. It also shows that the traffic involved has been handled on a profitable basis under the authorized rates. It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that an extension is justified and should be granted. The extension, however, will be limited to a one-year period and made subject to such earlier modification or further extension as may be warranted by future developments.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the authority heretofore granted Ira P. Lamb in this proceeding be and it is hereby extended to May 11,
