FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Public Utilities Commission, by Decision No. 43287, dated September 13, 1949, authorized Oxnard Home Telephone Company to transfer and convey all its properties and assets to Associated Telephone Company, Ltd., and directed said Associated Telephone Company, Ltd. to file, on or before April 1, 1950, a copy of each of its proposed journal entries to record on its books the acquisition of said properties; and,

WHEREAS, Associated Telephone Company, Ltd. heretofore has filed its journal entry recording on its books the acquisition

of said properties and assets but has not filed entries distributing the purchase price to primary plant and other accounts; and,

WHEREAS, Associated Telephone Company, Ltd., in its supplemental application filed in the above entitled matter on March 31, 1950, reports that it has engaged the services of a valuation engineer for the purpose of making an inventory and appraisal of the properties acquired from Oxnard Home Telephone Company, and that it will not be in a position to file the journal entries distributing to primary accounts the cost of said properties until said inventory and appraisal is completed; and,

WHEREAS, applicant reports that an additional period of from sixty to ninety days is required to complete the inventory and appraisal and that accordingly an extension of time is desired to file the journal entries; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 43287, dated September 13, 1949, is hereby modified so as to permit Associated Telephone Company, Ltd. to file journal entries, referred to in paragraph 8 of the order in said decision, on or before July 1, 1950.

This order is effective upon the date hereof.
