FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

On March 29, 1950, American Stevedore Company, applicant in Application No. 29965, in above consolidated proceeding, filed a petition requesting a modification of Decision No. 43424, as amended, by extending the time within which to comply with Paragraph (2) (b) of Decision No. 43424, dated October 18, 1949, concerning the filing of tariffs and time schedules. The petitioner asserts that it has been informed by its tariff agent that said agent will be unable to complete the preparation of a tariff meeting the requirements of the Commission's regulations within the time provided in the original decision. It is further stated that said tariff agent has been ill and that the preparation of the tariffs has been complicated by rate increase orders.

The petitioner's request appears to be reasonable and not incompatible with the public interest and will be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the time within which the American Stevedore

Company, applicant in Application No. 29965, shall comply with the provisions of Paragraph (2) (b) of Decision No. 43424, dated October 18, 1949, is hereby extended until May 15, 1950.

In view of the fact that this order provides only for an extension of time, the effective date shall be the date hereof.
