## ORDER

The County of San Bernardino is authorized to reconstruct and widen the crossing of Central Avenue at grade with the tracks of Southern Pacific Company (Crossing No. B-517.9) near Ontario, San Bernardino County, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than 80 feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B), relocated to provide for the widened roadway. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied

with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
