FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Commission, by Decision No. 44050, dated April 18, 1950, authorized Coast Van & Storage, Inc. to transfer its warehouse operative rights to Coast Van Lines, Incorporated, and directed said companies to make the appropriate supplements to the tariffs now on file with the Commission on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, and

WHEREAS, it appears that it is the desire of applicants for Coast Van Lines, Incorporated, to engage in the warehouse operations forthwith, and

Good Cause Appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the second ordering paragraph in the order in said Decision No. 44050 be, and it hereby is, amended to read as follows:

"2. Applicants on not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and to the public, shall supplement or reissue tariffs on file with the Commission insofar as they name rates, rules and regulations governing warehouse operations of Coast Van & Storage, Inc. to show that said Coast Van & Storage, Inc. has withdrawn and that Coast Van Lines, Incorporated, has adopted or

established as its own said rates, rules and regulations. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall in all respects comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of warehouse tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61."

This order is effective upon the date hereof.
