In the Matter of the Application of <u>CALIFORNIA-PACIFIC UTILITIES COMPANY</u> for an order authorizing it to execute its Fourth Supplemental Indenture to be dated as of May 1, 1950.

ORDER

Application

California-Pacific Utilities Company is a California corporation engaged in the public utility business in several western states. Heretofore, pursuant to authority granted by this Commission, it executed its First Mortgage Indenture, dated as of July 1, 1944, and three indentures supplemental thereto, and it issued under the terms of said indentures, and now has outstanding, \$4,250,000 of bonds. It now asks permission to execute a Fourth Supplemental Indenture, dated as of May 1, 1950.

Under the terms of said First Mortgage Indenture, applicant is permitted to acquire public utility property in the states of California, Oregon, Nevada, Idaho and Arizona. It now reports that it desires to amend the indenture so as to permit it to acquire public utility property in Utah and Wyoming, and it proposes, with the written consent of the holders of at least 75% in principal amount of the outstanding bonds, to execute a further supplemental indenture to carry its proposed amendments into effect.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary, and that the

application should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that California-Pacific Utilities Company may execute a Fourth Supplemental Indenture, dated as of May 1, 1950, in substantially the same form as that filed in this application.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that within thirty (30) days after the execution of such indenture, applicant shall file two (2) copies thereof with this Commission.

This order is effective upon the date hereof.
