OPINION AND ORDER

Floyd W. Rail and Bradford O. Stowell, copartners, conduct a public utility warehouse operation at Murrieta, Riverside County. The property is leased from A. Z. Howard and B. H. Barnett. Authority to lease the property to Rail is here sought. Stowell proposes to withdraw from the warehouse business. Rail, who has managed the warehouse for several years, will continue the public utility operations. No change in rates or in service available to the public is involved.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that A. Z. Howard and B. H. Barnett are authorized to enter into a lease with Floyd W. Rail in a form substantially the same as that attached to the application; that Floyd W. Rail and Bradford O. Stowell, copartners, may within sixty (60) days after the effective date hereof transfer to Floyd W. Rail the public utility warehouse operations involved in this proceeding; that prior to the effective date of said transfer, Floyd W. Rail and Bradford O. Stowell, copartners, and Floyd W. Rail shall, on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public, supplement

or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission insofar as they name rates, rules and regulations governing the warehouse operations here involved to show that Floyd W. Rail and Bradford O. Stowell, copartners, have withdrawn or canceled and that Floyd W. Rail has concurrently adopted or established as his own, said rates, rules and regulations; and that the tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall in all other respects comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of warehouse tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
