## OPINTON

Syde J. Kalil and William E. Martin, presently conduct a passenger stage service between Benicia and Fairfield-Suisun (1) Army Air Base and intermediate points. Applicants request the Commission to approve the use of U. S. Highway No. 40 from the point where it is intersected by State Highway No. 21 to the city limits of Fairfield, as an alternate route.

Applicants allege that County Road No. 76, a portion of their authorized route, is in need of repair; that during the period of preparation for and the progress of such repairs said road will be in such condition as to put an unusual maintenance burden on their transportation equipment.

Pacific Greyhound Lines has advised the Commission in writing that it will not protest the granting of the application.

Upon consideration of all the facts the Commission is of the opinion that the application should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That ordering paragraph (2)c of Decision No. 43892, dated March 7, 1950, is amended by the addition of the following:

> As an alternate to be used in connection with and as a part of the above route: Via U. S. Highway No. 40 from the point of its intersection with State Highway No. 21 to the city limits of Fairfield. No service shall be rendered over said alternate to, from or between Cordelia Junction and Fairfield, including all intermediate points.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days after the date hereof.
