SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

ORIGINAL

By Decision No. 43698, dated January 17, 1950, Mattie E. Haney was authorized to sell, and R. W. Sparling, Inc. was authorized to purchase and acquire, for \$17,000, the certificates of public convenience and necessity, and certain specified properties of the Topanga Canyon Public Utility Water System. This order prescribed certain conditions among which is the following:

- (1) The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall be made on or before the 28th day of February, 1950, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission within thirty (30) days after the date on which it is concluded.

At the request of the parties, and it appearing that the final conveyance was delayed due to difficulties encountered in the course of the title search and the securing of title insurance, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the foregoing condition be amended to read as follows:

- (1) The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall be made on or before the 1st day of June, 1950, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission within thirty (30) days after the date on which it is concluded.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
