ORDER OF REVOCATION

Jennie M. Goulding herein requests the Commission to revoke the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted her by Decision No. 43124, dated July 12, 1949, in Application No. 30054.

Petitioner alleges that because of her serious illness she has heretofore discontinued all service thereunder and does not intend to reinstate it.

The Commission is of the opinion that the petition should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 43124, dated July 12, 1949, in Application No. 30054, be and it is hereby revoked and annulled.

(2) That all effective tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission in the name of Jennie M. Goulding are hereby cancelled as of the effective date of this order.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
