OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, Howard Beeman and Bruce Beeman, copartners doing business as Beeman Bros. Warehouse, seek authority to transfer public utility warehouse property, located at Woodland, Yolo County, to Howard Beeman. The warehouse would thereafter be operated under the name of Howard Beeman Warehouse and Drier.

The verified application shows that Howard Beeman and Bruce Beeman have dissolved their partnership, that under the terms of the partnership dissolution Howard Beeman will acquire the entire warehouse property, and that no change is proposed in warehouse rates or in service available to the public.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Howard Beeman and Bruce Beeman, copartners, may, within sixty (60) days after the effective date hereof, transfer to Howard Beeman the warehouse property involved in this proceeding; that prior to the effective date of said transfer applicants shall, on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public, supplement or reissue tariffs on file with the Commission insofar as they name rates, rules and regulations

governing warehouse operations of Howard Beeman and Bruce Beeman, copartners, at Woodland, Yolo County, to show that they have withdrawn or canceled and that Howard Beeman has concurrently adopted or established as his own said rates, rules and regulations; and that the tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall in all other respects comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of warehouse tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
