OPINION AND ORDER

Percie C. Thacker, deceased, operated a public utility warehouse business at El Centro under the name of Pioneer Truck & Transfer Company. His estate, including the public utility warehouse property, has been ordered distributed to his widow, Margretta D. Thacker, by the Superior Court for Imperial County. Mrs. Thacker is also the administratrix of the estate. By this application she seeks authority from the Commission to transfer the public utility warehouse property in accordance with the distribution approved by the Superior Court. No change is proposed in warehouse rates or in service available to the public.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-entitled application be and it is hereby granted; that, within sixty (60) days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall supplement or reissue the tariff on file with the Commission naming rates, rules and regulations for the warehouse operations involved to show that

she has adopted or established as her own the rates, rules and regulations of that tariff; and that tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall in all other respects comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of warehouse tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
