O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Beach Street at 10th Street in Oceano, San Luis Obispo County, at the location described in the application.

It is alleged that Beach Street is not at present open to public use and travel, and this order is not to be deemed authority for such opening.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant states that the track crossing is required for immediate use by the industry to be served and requests that this authority be made effective as of its date.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
