O P I N I O N

Pacific Greyhound Lines herein requests authority to operate its passenger stages over an alternate route on relocated U. S. Highway 50 south of Folsom, serving no intermediate points. In that area a new section has been constructed for a distance of approximately six miles, by-passing the City of Folsom.

Applicant alleges that it is to the advantage of its passengers and in the public interest that such of its operations as are not required to pass through its Folsom terminal be rerouted over this new section of highway, thereby avoiding traffic congestion in the city streets.

Under the circumstances alleged, we find that public convenience and necessity require that the application be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

The Commission having found that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity

be and it is hereby granted to Pacific Greyhound Lines authorizing the establishment and operation of services as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 24 of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of passengers and their baggage, and express not exceeding 100 pounds in weight per shipment, to be transported on passenger carrying vehicles only, over the relocated section of U. S. Highway 50 south of Folsom, between the junctions of the former U. S. Highway 50 and the present U. S. Highway 50 southwest and southeast of Folsom; provided, however, that no passengers, baggage or express may be picked up or discharged on the relocated section. This certificate is granted as an extension of and is consolidated with applicant's present operative rights created by Decision No. 23244, in Application No. 16989.

(2) That applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days after the effective date hereof.

This order shall become effective 20 days after the date hereof.
