## ORDER

The City of Mill Valley, Marin County, is authorized to construct Reed and Evergreen Streets at grade across a track of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company in that city, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings No. 5-10.6 and No. 5-10.7, respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of each crossing shall be not less than 2+ feet and grades of approach substantially as shown on the prints attached to the application (Exhibits B and C). Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G.O. No. 75-B) at each crossing.

within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or medified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
