O R D E R

The City of Bakersfield, Kern County, is authorized to re-construct and widen the crossing of 30th Street at grade with tracks of Southern Pacific Company, (Crossing No. B-311.5) in that city, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals. (G.O.No. 75-B). The existing Standard No. 3 signal shall be relocated as shown on Exhibit "A".

Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
