FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decision No. 44307 in the above-entitled application, Southern Pacific Company was authorized to construct a crossing at grade with County Road No. 10 near Heber, Imperial County, and said decision provided that the crossing be constructed without superelevation. It appears, however, due to the grade of said County Road, that a superior crossing can be provided if superelevation of approximately 2 inches is permitted.

Good Cause Appearing IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 44307 is hereby modified by elimination of the words "without superelevation." In all other respects Decision No. 44307 is in full force and effect.
