ORDER REVOKING CERTIFICATE

On May 23, 1950, by Decision No. 44206, the Commission granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to Rogers and Davison, authorizing them to transport passengers and baggage, as a passenger stage corporation, between Fresno and the proposed site of Dam No. 7, Big Creek Power House No. 4 of Southern California Edison Company, and intermediate points, excluding service between Fresno and Auberry.

On June 29, 1950, applicants, through their counsel, advised the Commission in writing that, due to unforeseen changes in plans for the dam, there is no longer the public demand for the service contemplated by the application herein. The letter states: "For that reason, applicants are not filing a written acceptance of the certificate as provided in the order."

Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued to applicants on May 23, 1950, by Decision No. 44206 herein, be and it hereby is revoked.
