O R D E R

McCloud River Railroad Company is authorized to construct a branch main track at grade across State Highway Route 83 near Bartle, Siskiyou County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 26B-0.5. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1A crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B).

No train, engine or motor shall be operated over said crossing unless it shall have first been brought to a stop and traffic on the highway protected by a competent employee of applicant acting as a flagman.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. .

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
