SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. <u>444633</u> entered today in this proceeding established state-wide minimum rates, rules and regulations for the transportation of cement, and for the transportation of lime, cement flue dust, and powdered limestone in mixed shipments with cement, when shipped in quantities of 38,000 pounds or more. The rates, rules and regulations partly supersede provisions of City Carriers' Tariff No. 7 - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 9 (Appendix "A" to Decision No. 35055 in Cases Nos. 4246 and 4434). That tariff will be amended accordingly.
