OPINION AND ORDER

Robert H. Reed, doing business as Harbor Cold Storage, conducts a public utility cold storage warehouse operation at Newport Beach devoted largely to the storage of fish and seafood. Authority to lease the warehouse facilities to John McCarthy is here sought. Reed proposes to withdraw from the warehouse business. McCarthy, who has had more experience in the fish and seafood business, will continue the public utility operations. No change in rates or in service available to the public is proposed.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Robert H. Reed is authorized to enter into a lease with John McCarthy in a form substantially the same as that attached to the application; that Robert H. Reed may within sixty (60) days after the effective date hereof transfer to John McCarthy the public utility warehouse operations involved in this proceeding; that prior to the effective date of said transfer, Robert H. Reed and John McCarthy shall, on not less than

five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public, supplement or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission insofar as they name rates, rules and regulations governing the warehouse operations here involved to show that Robert H. Reed has withdrawn or canceled and that John McCarthy has concurrently adopted or established as his own, said rates, rules and regulations; and that the tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall in all other respects comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of warehouse tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
