ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 40708 in Application No. 28695 Lynn H. Berry and Lee S. Bogue, were authorized to acquire from James B. Rockwell and H. S. Sims, highway common carrier and passenger stage operative rights between Etna and Somes Bar.

On August 2, 1950 Lynn H. Berry and Lee S. Bogue filed a petition with the Commission requesting revocation of those operative rights asserting as justification thereof that the entire operations had been abandoned on June 30, 1950. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the operative rights acquired by Lynn H. Berry and Lee S. Bogue pursuant to said Decision No. 40708, in Application No. 28695, are hereby revoked and annulled and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Lynn H. Berry and Lee S. Bogue, are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
