According to applicant, no other highway common carrier is concerned in the subject matter of the above entitled application.

It appears that public convenience and necessity do not require the continued operation between Donovan Junction and Byron over the Marsh Creek Road. A public hearing does not appear necessary.

## ORDER

Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That Pacific Greyhound Lines is hereby authorized to discontinue and abandon operations between Donovan Junction and Byron over the Marsh Creek Road.
- (2) That the portion of subdivision 2 in Decision No. 34238 in Application No. 24155 authorizing operations between Donovan Junction and Byron over the Marsh Creek Road is hereby revoked and annulled. In all other respects, Decision No. 34238 shall remain in full force and effect.
- (3) That applicant shall file in triplicate appropriate supplements to its tariffs and time tables within sixty (60) days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five (5) days notice to the Commission and the public showing the discontinuance of service as heretofore authorized.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
