ORDER

Applicant requests authority to change the grade crossing protection at certain crossings of its main line over streets in Sacramento, as hereinafter specified. The installation of such signals will replace existing center-of-the-street wigwag signals.

It appears the said changes in crossing protection are desirable and the application will be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted to The Western Pacific Railroad Company to install two No. 8 Flashing Light Signals (G. O. No. 75-B) at each of the following crossings at grade with streets in the city of Sacramento, in lieu of the existing protection:

4-137.9	"S" Street	No. 4 Center-of-street Wigwag
4-138.0	"Q" Street	-do-
4-138.2	"O" Street	-do-

4-138.9	"F" Street	1 No. 1 Crossing Sign
4-139.0	"E" Street	No. 4 Center-of-street Wigwag

subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Signals at the crossings of "S", "Q", "O", "N", and "G" Streets shall be installed in conformity with the requirements of G. O. No. 75-B.
- (2) Signals at the crossings of "E" and "F" Streets shall be located on the vehicular approach side of the tracks, facing on-coming traffic, due to the fact that these two streets carry only traffic in one direction.

- (3) Applicant is authorized to omit bells from all No. 8 Flashing Light Signals herein authorized.
- (4) Applicant shall within thirty days thereafter notify the Commission in writing of the completion of the installation of said signals and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.
- (5) This authority shall become void if not exercised within one year after the effective date of this order, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
