ORDER

Applicant requests authority to install two No. 8 flashing lights at certain crossings of its main line over streets in Hayward, as hereinafter specified. The installation of such signals will replace existing No. 1 crossing signs.

It appears that said changes in crossing protection are desirable and the application will be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted to The Western Pacific Railroad Company to install two No. 8 flashing light signals (G.O. No. 75-B) at each of the following crossings at grade with streets in the City of Hayward, in lieu of the existing protection:

Crossing Number	Name of Street	Existing Protection to be Removed
4-21.0	Sycamore Road	l - #l crossing sign
4-22.4	Soronson Road	l - #1 crossing sign

subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Signals at the crossings of Sycamore Road and Soronson Road shall be installed in conformity with the requirements of G.O. No. 75-B.
- (2) Flashing light signals shall be equipped with a reflectorized sign reading "Stop on Red Signal".

- (3) Applicant shall, within thirty days thereafter, notify the Commission in writing of the completion of the installation of said signals and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.
- (4) This authority shall become void if not exercised within one year after the effective date of this order, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
