## OPINION

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 697.1 of the Vehicle Code of the State of California, Key System Transit Lines by Decision No. 44289 in Application No. 31128 was authorized to use motor coaches in excess of 35 feet but not in excess of 40 feet over-all length on its "K" Motor Coach Line between Oakland and San Francisco. This "K" Motor Coach Line was authorized for operation in lieu of the "A" Transbay Rail Line between Oak Street and Havenscourt Blvd. in Oakland. In the present application, Key System Transit Lines requests authority to operate motor coaches of over 35 feet in length on all of its transbay motor coach lines between San Francisco and points in the East Bay cities. Applicant alleges that the authority sought for in this application will permit it to use the motor coaches authorized for the "K" Line on the other transbay lines during off-peak hours, at nights, and on Saturdays and Sundays and at other times when the larger coaches might be available. It appears that the other transbay motor coach lines are not materially different than the "K" Line insofar as street and traffic conditions are concerned.

Applicant has on hand the motor coaches for use on the "K" Line and desires to use certain of these coaches on some of the above lines immediately in order to break in the drivers before the establishment of the "K" Line service; therefore, this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
