In the matter of application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of drill track across Olive Road and Rawson Avenue in the County of Tehama, State of California.

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Rawson Avenue and Olive Road in Tehama County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings No. C-219.4-C and No. 219.5-C respectively. Construction of each of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue and road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadways and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B) at each location. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
