O R D E R

The verified application of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station at Allensworth during the past year and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station at Allensworth, County of Tulare; to abandon and remove a box car body depot and living quarters at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
