ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Twelfth Street and Canal Avenue in the City of Long Beach, at the location described in the application, the track across Canal Avenue to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 6LD-2.04, and that across Twelfth Street as Crossing No. 6LD-2.09-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation, and of a width to conform to the portion of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding two (2) per cent. Protection for Crossing No. 6LD-2.09-C shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign, and at Canal Street by existing protection.

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
