FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 44646, dated August 15, 1950, the Commission authorized Paul Ludolph Company to transfer a certificate of public convenience and necessity to Ted Peters, and authorized Ted Peters to issue a note in the principal amount of not exceeding \$2,000.

The Commission now is advised that the true and correct name of the purchaser of said certificate is Theo Peters, and that Ted Peters is the firm name under which he operates. The Commission is asked to amend its order in its decision accordingly; therefore,

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 44646, dated August 15, 1950, is hereby amended by substituting the name Theo Peters, doing business as Ted Peters, for the name Ted Peters wherever the name Ted Peters now appears in said order.
