ORDER OF REVOCATION

In this proceeding, A. Earl Wion requests the Commission to revoke and annul the passenger stage operative right created by Decision No. 34323 in Application 24219.

Said Decision No. 34323 granted a certificate to applicant authorizing the transportation of passengers and express between Jackson and Ray's Twin Lakes Resort and intermediate points. Thereafter by Decision No. 40537 in Application No. 28527, the Commission authorized applicant to suspend the service authorized by said Decision No. 34323 until December 31, 1947, subject to the condition that if the service should not be reestablished and operated for the entire season of 1948, the operative right created by said Decision No. 34323 would be revoked and annulled.

The supplemental application here considered states that service between Jackson and Ray's Twin Lakes Resort was not operated during the entire summer season of 1948, as required by said Decision No. 40537, nor during any part thereof, nor at any time since. Therefore, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the operative rights created by Decision No. 34323 in Application No. 24219 are hereby revoked and

annulled and all effective tariffs and time tables in the name of applicant on file with the Commission are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
